1) Buddhist Cave no. 1 to 5 | Dharmas

1) Temple of Dharmas - This is ninth century of Dharmas. Locally it is called Dharmas or Dharmas.

⇒ This temple is made on solid natural rock.

⇒ Sabnmandap is in the entrance. Shrine is in north Indian style.

⇒ Architecture is similar to Dharmas. Was temple to Kailash temple of Ellora.

⇒ There is a big temple in middle of more temple around the main temple.

⇒ Big Shivaling is given along with a sculpture of Vishnu. In the entrance figures of Vishnu and Lakshmi were given.

⇒ It is made by hollow a big rock by a mtr. It is made by a single block that is why it is called Monolithic. It is carved out of a solid rock 50m x 20m x 9m

⇒ Architecture is beautiful unique example of rock cut temple.

Dhammar buckhist caves → It is located Dhammar near temple. They are 51 caves in which Shupa, chaitya were given.

⇒ It is made in 5th cen. AD. located in Chandwada village.

⇒ 14 caves are historically significant among them Badli, Kacheri and Bhinia Bagoas are very important.

⇒ Badli Kacheri cave measured 20 ft. square in which Shupa and Chaityas were given.

⇒ Bhinia Bagoas is the largest measuring 115 ft by 80 ft. including 13000 and chaitya grotto.

⇒ An caves has a planned masonry with more than 70 living quarters, pavilions, meditation halls, stupas and image of Buddha and his disciples.

⇒ A large image of Buddha stands at the entrance of a pavilion.

⇒ Nearby an image of Kubera the God of wealth and equally in Buddhist iconography.

⇒ A chiseled image of Buddha in Nirvana mudra depicted. His disciples were standing and watching the Lord attaining Nirvana.

⇒ ~~There~~ Monks of Hinayana and Mahayana sects of Buddhism found here.

⇒ The site is needs conservation because laterite rocks were used for making the site.

⇒ Laterite mortar used by ASI ^{SUNDAY 9} block
Circle for preservation.
