→ This site is situated on river Narmada in district Nimar west of Madhya Pradesh. This is situated on Maheshwar.

→ This site is excavated between 1957 and 1959 over two seasons by Deccan College Pune.

→ It is vast Chalcolithic settlement. Excavation revealed two periods of which Period I was Chalcolithic further divisible into 4 sub periods and Period II belongs to Iron age.

→ We will deal with period I only as Chalcolithic culture. This period lies between 1600 B.C. to 1300 B.C.

Sub Period IA

Phase I belongs to Malwa ware along with white painted black and red ware. Two techniques of pottery making developed in this phase. A mud house was destroyed by fire in this layer.

IA continued in Phase II also along with hand made coarse ware. Some Torve Ware also found on this phase which belongs to Torve Chalcolithic culture. So in this layer 2 type of Chalcolithic cultures were surviving together.

~~Phase~~ Sub Period IC → BRW disappeared in this phase. Other wares like Malwa⁻, coarse red ware and Torve ware were continued.

Sub Period ID → All the ware in this layer. Unpainted BRW were also used. Torve ware became prominent. Malwa ware in less quantity.

Tue

→ Other Chalcolithic antiquities were also retrieved like microliths, Copper chisels, arrow head, fish hooks (prominent things), shell bangles etc. found.

→ Whole structure were round or rectangular, on wooden posts.

→ Evidence of domestic animals like

sheep, goats pigs etc. found.

→ One ceramic goblet of Malwa ware is very famous pottery of this place.

→ Next phase is not Chalcolithic culture. Period II belongs to Iron culture.
