- (1) lack of adequate ratio of teachers.
- (2) low usage of technology in teaching process.

- (6) lack of Internet facility for teachers as well as for students.

- (1). Recruit more permanent faculty members.
- (2).Increase use of technology in teaching aid to instill interest among students. The department should be equipped with modern teaching aids like LED projectors, interactive boards, etc.
- (3). The departments should be provided with sufficient freedom in terms of spending. MSW being a practical subject requires continuous and frequent interaction with society but because of non-availability of funds the students are forced to opt out of such interaction and are also restricted to such interaction in local or nearby area.
- (4). The department should be allowed to establish its own departmental library. The freedom to subscribe to journal and also to purchase books should lie on individual faculty members rather than 'degenerative' centralized purchasing mechanism.
- (5). The campus should be equipped with high speed wifi connectivity and access to inflibnet (UGC initiated library resources)
- (6). Digitalized attendance system.
- (7). The most important recommendation for the proper functioning of the university teaching system is to make university administration responsive towards teachers. Presently teachers
