Inscriptions of Harshvardhan

(606-647)

⇒ Harshvardhan became the king of Thaneswar later Kinnyu became his Capital.

⇒ He expand his empire from Thaneswar in north to Pannwala gulf in M.P. similarly Gangan in east to Vallabhi in west.

⇒ A vastland of Madhya Pradesh came in his empire.

⇒ So important inscriptions of Harsh were the source of history of Harsh similarly some seals were also found in the very places of his region.

⇒ Bans khola Inscriptions - Although it is not situated in M.P. but still this inscription is most in remnant inscriptions of Harshwardhan.

⇒ Banskheda is a village of Shahjahanpur (U.P.) - This inscription is on copper plate.

⇒ This inscription Harshwardhan donated "Markat Sagar" village of Anguliga Vishay of Alichhatra khushi to two brahmins Gaudchandra and Bhattsvarni.

⇒ In the necessary Pushyabuti's name was not given.

⇒ In this inscription ancieties of Harsha and their religious belief are also given.

⇒ Some officials and other administrators detail of is also given in this inscriptions

⇒ Some account of Devraj and Shashank is also given.

⑧ Madhavani inscription - Madhavani is situated in Aneshi Tehsil of Ayazgaon district of U.P.

It is dated 631 AD.
⇒ It mentions the grant of Somvard 2000
